

Adult Choir

Our Choir sings from about September through June – normally at the 10:00 a.m. Sunday mass. We have choir practice (Sept. - June) on Thursday evenings from 7:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. (with some extended and extra rehearsals near Christmas and Easter). You need to enjoy singing and love the Lord. You don't have to audition. We work hard, but we also have FUN doing it!!! From "traditional" to "contemporary", plus spirituals, and other styles as well, we are flexible and joyful in what we sing, and everything we do is an offering to God and a service to the congregation.

Responsibilities

Attendance at weekly Sunday masses and Thursday night rehearsals is very important. It is, of course, understood that life events come up and it is impossible to be there 100% of the time. Due to the extensive liturgical schedule of our parish, participation at each and every celebration for which the choir is needed is not required; however, regular participation - is expected.

FAQ'S

Do I have to audition?

No. However, but you must be able to sing 'on-pitch' and it would be helpful if singers could read music.

When are rehearsals?

Thursday nights 7:30 – 9:00pm. (September - June). (with some extended and extra rehearsals near Christmas and Easter).

What is the commitment level?

Fairly high (especially around Christmas and Easter). If you unable to commit to a full season, consider a half season (September – Christmas) or (January – Easter).

How old do I have to be?

You must be of High School age or older.
